PSCA Annual State Shoot Meeting

Location: The Shooting Academy at Nemaocolin, Farmington, PA

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:36 PM by President Ricky Fung-A-Fat.

Welcome: Ricky Fung-A-Fat welcomed all in attendance.

Minutes: Warren Kerstetter read the minutes from the 2010 annual state meeting held at the State Shoot at Thunder Ridge Sporting Clays in Middlebury Center, PA. Bob Saunders made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Mark Hull seconded the motion.

Treasurer's Report: Ricky Fung-A-Fat reviewed the annual treasurer's report. Copies were handed out to all. Ricky noted that there was one correction to the report: cost for shells were listed as income, but should have been listed as an expense instead. Bob Whitmore made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, which was seconded by Jeff Wolfe.

Discussion: Several attendees expressed concerns about trophies not being ordered for the Sub-gauge and Prelim winners for the current shoot. Pros and cons of ordering trophies before versus after state shoots were discussed. Clubs could save money if trophies are ordered after the shoot. When purchasing trophies beforehand, money is lost by the club when buying for winners in categories in which there are no shooters. It was announced that some trophies purchased from Jim White could be returned. Discussion focused on whether it might be a good idea to have trophies ordered after winners have been determined for future state shoots. It was decided that PSCA officers and the board will take this into consideration as they will be reviewing the guidelines for state shoots.
