PSCA Meeting Agenda for 6/9/07

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order @ 5:52 p.m. by President Clyde Keller.

Attendance

Reading of Meeting Minutes

Steve distributed copies of the minutes from the May meeting. Rodger motioned to accept the minutes as distributed, 2nd by Randy, with all in favor.

Reading of Treasurer's Report

Jeff distributed and reviewed the Treasurer's Report. This year to date we have received \$14,069.00 in target fees. We have \$14,000.00 in a CD which matures 02/22/08. The checking account balance of \$21,713.85 will be used toward the funds needed for the remainder of the year, with the balance being set aside for the 2009 year shoots to be awarded next month. Roy Sisler suggested re-evaluating the marketing of the major state shoots (zones and championship) and enlightening the shooters about the state funds, in an effort to increase the attendance. Rodger motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report, 2nd by Mark Hull, with all in favor.

Old Business:

- 1. State Shoot Planning
 - o Guns Clyde has arranged to purchase a Technys for the meeting giveaway gun. Sporting 391's will be used for the card raffle and for the guns donated to the club.
 - Trophies Roy Sisler confirmed that the trophies have arrived at the club and the order is complete. Jeff has sent payment to Prize Possessions. The board will continue to research trophy options, etc. in an effort to reduce future shoot costs.
 - o Shells The shells have been ordered and delivered to Hunting Hills.
 - Raffle The winner of the card raffle will be picked during the party Saturday night.
 - O Meeting There will be no PSCA Table this year and the meeting will be conducted in the same format as last year. All of the perspective host clubs will give a presentation at the meeting on Friday night. Any voting will be by ballot, throughout the weekend. The 2009 shoot host clubs will be announced during the awards presentation on Sunday.
 - Costs We had an ongoing discussion throughout the meeting on costs and ways to increase shooter attendance numbers. This will be one of the main focus points of the board at future meetings.

2. PSCA Shoot Update

- O PA Zone Shoots Factoryville held a great event in the East, but had a low attendance, especially on Saturday. There were approximately 60 shooters on Saturday, with 115 for the Main on Sunday. The discussion of possible causes was the predicted bad weather, fuel costs, etc. Stonycreek was doing a good job so far and well on their way to having a successful event. Possible points for improvement were working on a faster and smoother registration process and more frequent and faster event results.
- O PA State Championships Roy Sisler informed everyone that Hunting Hills will again have a steak dinner at the celebration party planned Saturday night. They will use multiple target setters on totally different courses throughout the weekend, including a new course, never shot before.
- 3. Scholastic Clay Target Program Will be held June 16th @ Central Penn Sporting Clays. The event had 42 shooters last year and has grown to an expected 60+ for this year's event. The PSCA will contribute awards and gift cards to the participants.
- 4. Keystone Games Clyde informed everyone in attendance the program and the PSCA board's involvement.
- 5. National Delegate Update Randy gave an update on various topics of interest going on with the NSCA and that all the information is available on the NSCA website.

New Business:

- 1. Rodger announced that Lehigh Valley Sporting Clays will no longer be holding registered tournaments.
- 2. We had a brief discussion on raising the price cap on the PA Zone Shoots, which we tabled until the August meeting.
- 3. Randy suggested the PSCA pay the main event entry fee for the PA State Champion to attend the Zone II Championship or Nationals. The board will address this subject at future meetings.

<u>Future Meetings</u>: The Annual Meeting will be held Friday, July 13th at 7 pm. The board will try to keep the meeting to the same length and format as last year.
