

## **PSCA Meeting 6/18/2010**

**Location:** Blue Ridge Sportsmen's Club

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:41 p.m. by Vice President Rodger Becker.

**Attendance:** Rodger Becker, Steve Stambaugh, Jeff Lutz, Steve Zimmers, Warren Kerstetter and Club Representative Mike Koneski were in attendance.

**Meeting Minutes:** Steve Stambaugh distributed copies of the previous meeting minutes with everyone having an opportunity for review. Warren motioned to accept the minutes as presented. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve Zimmers, with all in favor.

**Treasurer's Report:** Jeff distributed copies and reviewed the Treasurer's Report. (see attached) Jeff reported that we are less than \$1800 from reaching the projected budget in target fees for the year. Since we have the target fees from both Zone Shoots and the State Championship to arrive yet we'll easily surpass the budget. Steve Stambaugh motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve Zimmers, with all in favor.

### **2010 State Championship:**

- ✓ **Guns-** Jeff had a list of the available guns provided by Ken Piestrak. The board reviewed the list. Warren made a motion to buy 5 guns, 3 would go to the club and 2 would go for the Target Incentive Program. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve Zimmers, with all in favor. (See attached)
- ✓ **Trophies-** The trophy order has arrived at Thunder Ridge and is correct.
- ✓ **Shells-** The PSCA will purchase 30 flats from Shyda's for the \$1500 budget. They will be RIO 1oz. 3dram loads of Top Sporting (\$50.87 w/tax).
- ✓ **Update-** Warren presented the update from Thunder Ridge. The club has restoned the roads, increased the size of station #16, and has Jiffy Johns coming and plenty of traps ordered. Richland will be donating an entry to the Moxie Open – Bill & Irene have asked if other clubs would help out with sponsorship & donations also.

### **PSCA Zone Shoot Update:**

- 2010 Eastern Zone – Central Penn – Everyone who attended thought the targets were good and they did a good job for their first zone shoot. The main complaint with the shoot was that there were no master sheets at the stations and the shooters were required to sign their scorecards after shooting each station.
- 2010 Western Zone – Buffer Creek – The targets were also good at this shoot. Everything was well run and it was evident this was their 2<sup>nd</sup> Zone shoot. Jeff thought the crew from Nemaocolin deserved a lot of credit for all their work and help they provided.
- 2011 Eastern Zone – will be hosted by Rock Mountain.
- 2011 Western Zone – will be hosted by Castlewood.

### **PSCA State Championship Update:**

- 2011 – The PSCA will assign a buddy once the new officers are in place and they will have to contact Nemaocolin to check on the status.

**2012 PSCA Shoots/Ballots:** Rock Mountain is the only applicant for the State Championship. Currently Central Penn is the applicant for the East Zone, with an application from Blue Ridge pending. Critter Path and Stonycreek have both submitted applications for the West Zone. Rodger will forward a complete list for ballots to be created.

Steve Zimmers reported that the above list is the only nominations that have been received, with July 1<sup>st</sup> being the deadline for submission. He will forward all the information to Steve Stambaugh for creation of ballots and reporting at the Annual Meeting.

**SCTP:** The State Championship is currently being held this weekend at Nemaocolin.

**Website:** Warren's address and number are incorrect. Jeff will continue to update the info as time permits.

**National Delegate Update:** Jeff will email Randall for a list of the PA target count for 2009.

**New Business:**

**T.I.P. Flyers:** The attendees reviewed the advertisement Steve Stambaugh had put together as a sample. (See attached) After a brief discussion, the flyer was approved as is. Steve Stambaugh will email a PDF copy to Jeff for posting on the website. Jeff will also email blast a link to the shooters and clubs.

**Future Meetings:** There will be no interim meeting prior to the Annual Meeting. The Annual Meeting is scheduled for Saturday night during the State Championship following any shoot-offs. The exact time and location will be posted at shoot registration.

**Meeting Adjournment:** Steve Zimmers made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Koneski, with all in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 8:37 p.m.
